On July 1, 2010, United Farm Workers of America (UFW) informed the Board that on June 23, 2010, it had produced to both counsel for Respondent and to the ALRB's Visalia Regional Office copies of complete payroll records for San Joaquin Tomato Growers, Inc. (Employer) for the calendar years 1991, 1992, 1993 and 1994. The UFW argues that these records provide information that would make it possible for the ALRB's Regional Director to calculate an initial makewhole specification in the above-captioned case. Therefore, the UFW requests that the Board dismiss the Motion to Close Case Without Full Compliance filed by the Regional Director in the above-captioned case on May 15, 2009. The UFW also requests that the Board cancel the hearing in that matter currently scheduled for July 20, 2010.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board requests that Employer and the Visalia Regional Director submit responses to the UFW's request to dismiss the Motion to Close Case Without Full Compliance. Responses must be served and filed with the Executive Secretary in accordance with the Board's regulations and be postmarked on or before July 9, 2010. No further briefing in this matter shall be allowed unless requested by the Board.
