On May 12, 2015, the Agricultural Labor Relations Board (ALRB or Board), received a request from the ALRB's General Counsel for approval to file a petition for a temporary restraining order pursuant to Labor Code section 1160.4 in the Superior Court for the State of California, County of Fresno, regarding the above-entitled cases. Later that same day, in conformance with the Board's March 6, 2015 revised delegation of its authority to seek injunctive relief under Section 1160.4 of the Agricultural Labor Relations Act (ALRA or Act), the Board ruled on the request via a letter to the General Counsel. Therefore, pursuant to the procedures specified by the

Act and the Board's regulations,¹ the decision of whether to file the petition now lies with the General Counsel. Any filing must be made in accordance with the Board's conditional authorization of May 12, 2015.
